Library Card Information

All UA students need a St. Louis County Library card for classwork at Ursuline. Be sure to bring proof of residency (piece of mail, driver's license/permit) when you apply for or renew your card.

For Incoming Freshmen living in Illinois, Jefferson County, or Franklin County, enclosed is a library card application.

Freshmen will be given instruction on the use of the St. Louis County Library's website between September 1 and September 8, 2017. **Each student must have a card by that date.**

Laptop pickup

Lockers
