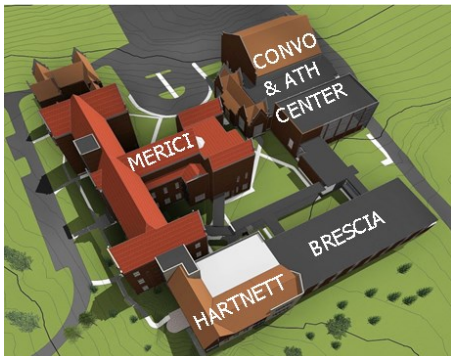


# Freshman Parent FAQs



## What are the buildings on campus?



- Merici Hall: Named for St. Angela Merici (ma-REE-chee), includes the main office, principal, president, counseling, advancement, board room, café and Bear Den.
- Brescia Hall: Named after Brescia (BRESH-uh), Italy, where St. Angela founded the Company of St. Ursula. Includes the assistant principal's office, campus ministry/mission effectiveness, library and classrooms.
- Convocation & Athletic Center: Includes the lobby/reception area known as O'Hara Hall, named for former UA president Sr. Madonna O'Hara, OSU, as well as the gymnasium, concession stand, fitness center, locker rooms, health classroom and auditorium. Linked to Brescia via Senior Hallway.

- Hartnett Hall: Named for longtime co-worker Mrs. Thelma Hartnett, our most recent addition connects Merici and Brescia, linking the entire campus together. Includes music and dance studios, science labs and an elevator serving Hartnett, Merici and Brescia.

## Where can I pick-up and drop-off my daughter?

Students may be dropped off in the front circle drive or the Monroe drop-off area. Pick up is in the same location. Please do *not* drop-off at the stop sign by the gym or the back circle drive.

## What is Serviam?

## What are Viaggio Days?

*Viaggio* (vee-ah-gee-o) means "journey" and is our freshman orientation program which will be held August 13-15.

If leaving for a doctor appointment, student must bring a note to the main office before 8am, sign out at the time of the appointment, sign in upon her return and bring a note from the doctor. If a student will have a planned absence of one day or longer, please obtain the appropriate form from the Brescia office one week in advance.

## How do I purchase books?

Books will be available to purchase through Follett, our virtual bookstore, starting July 11.

## Where can my daughter go before or after school?

Student proximity cards will open doors between 6:30am and 4:30pm with access to the café and library. Students may access the Convocation & Athletic Center from 6:30am until 7pm.
